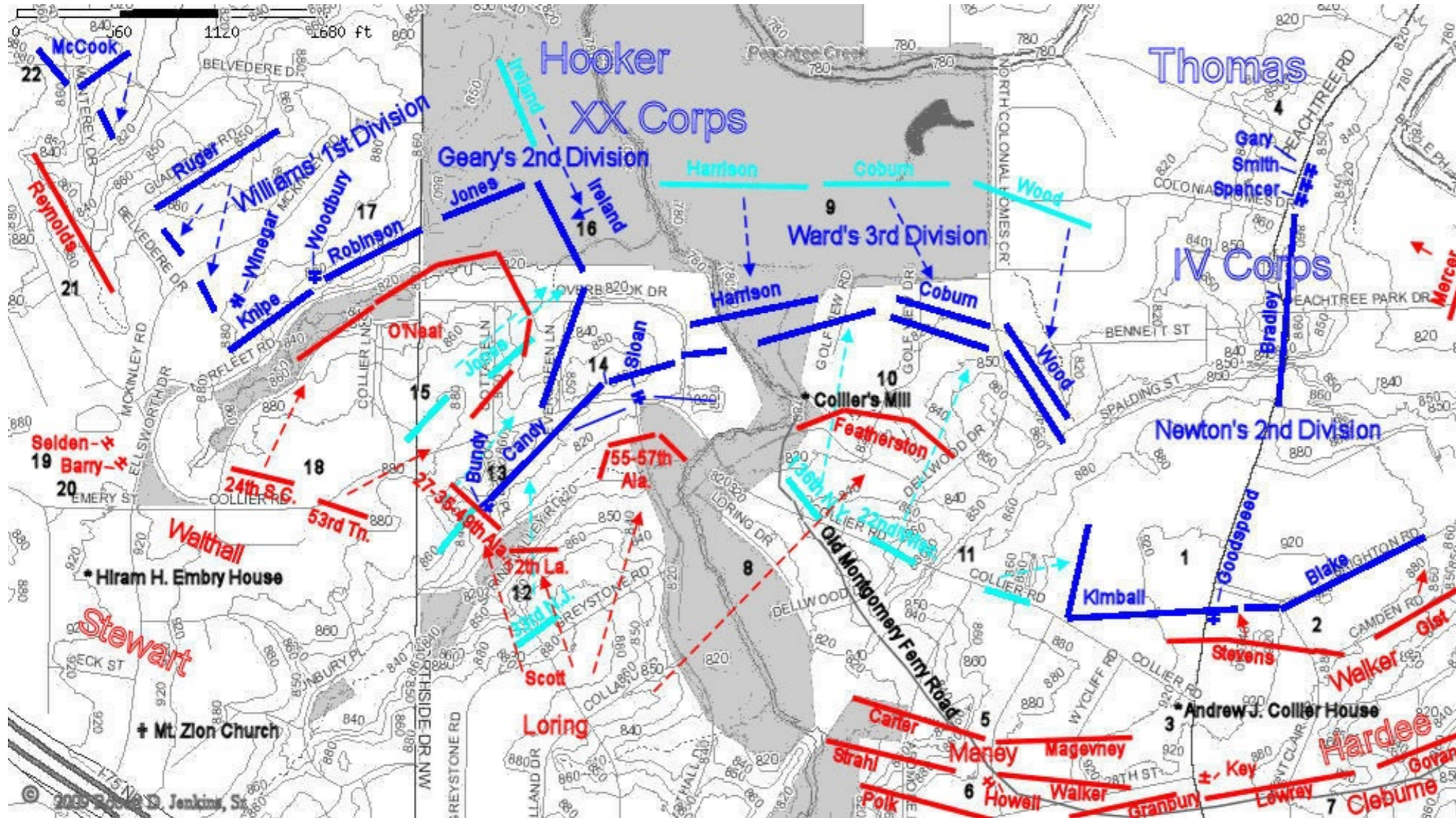


# The Battle of Peach Tree Creek, July 20, 1864

12. @ 4:25-the 33<sup>rd</sup> New Jersey is routed in woods by Scott's Brigade
13. Bundy's Battery is briefly captured
14. Candy's Brig. rallies & stops Scott as the 55<sup>th</sup> & 57<sup>th</sup> Ala. are slaughtered at Tanyard Park before Sloan's Battery
15. @ 4:40-O'Neal's Brig. sweeps Geary's Div. off ridge and many flee
16. Ireland's Brig. plugs the hole checking the rout for the moment
17. Williams' Div. holds firm, O'Neal is stopped but looks for reinforcements
18. @ 5:15-the 24<sup>th</sup> S.C. & 53<sup>rd</sup> Tn. rush to support O'Neal but are also stopped
19. @ 4:50-Major Preston is killed while directing Selden's Ala. Battery
20. Barry's Battery replaces Selden's Battery after it runs out of ammunition
21. @ 5:00-Reynolds' Brig. continues attack up Howell Mill Road
22. @ 5:15-Hapeman's 104<sup>th</sup> Illinois of McCook's Brig. stop Reynolds ending the last Confederate charge of the day

## Key:

1. Newton's Div. advances & takes heights along Buckhead Rd. @ 1:00 pm
2. Walker attacks & is repulsed- Stevens on Buckhead Rd & Gist on Camden @ 4:00
3. Stevens is mortally wounded below Collier House while drawing off his Brigade
4. Thomas personally directs artillery fire stopping Mercer's advance @ 4:15
5. Maney's Div. stops near Ardmore Park after observing Stevens' repulse

6. Howell's Battery goes into action below 28<sup>th</sup> Street heights
7. Cleburne's Div. replaces Walker @ 6:00 to renew attack but it is called off
8. Featherston's Brig. crosses Tanyard Branch & takes Collier Ridge @ 4:20
9. Ward's Div. responds with counterattack in ravine at Collier Mill
10. Spring where wounded from both sides gather for water in wooded ravine
11. Site of Barnard photo facing north-depicts Featherston/Ward fight
