

Witnesseth: That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of

Two Thousand, Three Hundred & Seventy Three and 50 Dollars, in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed; and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns,

all that tract or parcel of land, lying and being in Lake lot 114, of the 17th district of originally Henry County, Georgia, being 4.31/10 acres, more or less, described as follows: Commencing on the line of Holmes land at a point where the land herein described land lot 115 from 114, crosses a branch, running thence South, 17 degrees 30 minutes East, 1930 feet to the land lot line; thence West 13 degrees South, 70 feet along the lot line; thence North 3 degrees West, 2930 feet to across Rice's Ferry Road to the land lot line; thence in an Easterly direction along the land lot line, 820 feet, to the starting point. Said land is a part of the land bought by me from C. J. Bell and is the place wherein I now live, as per survey made by P. R. Lawrence, which appears upon the back hereof:
