


Our Holiday Raffle Winners

Dr. Robert L. Hope (1860-1938)

Many of you are familiar with Dr. Robert L. Hope's name because of his connection to Buckhead. He is known because of his extraordinary work with the poor of Atlanta in the late 19th Century. He was director and resident physician of the Fulton County Almshouse, 1881-1909 located in Buckhead.

Originally the Almshouse fronted on Peachtree Street near Piedmont Road. Later, R.L. Hope school was built, 1909, in honor of Dr. Hope because he was Fulton County School Board President from 1904-1905 and he donated the land.

The new "Almshouses" are still standing and in use at Chastain Park. One is occupied by Galloway School and the other by Chastain Arts Center.

Delia, his wife was one of the Plaster's Family, the owners of all the land around Rock Springs Presbyterian Church. Hope acquired quite a bit of land wealth, buying his needy brothers-in-laws' properties as they offered them.
