
Peachtree Heights East Walking Tour

With approximately 330 homes within this unique neighborhood, houses in Peachtree Heights East include early 20th century American two story four-square, Craftsman Bungalow, Cape Cod, Tudor Revival, Mission Revival, and Ranch to 21st century home styles. We will see examples of several of those on the tour. The mile and a half tour route is hilly and the tour will last about an hour and a half. We ask participants to stay on the road during the tour.
